The 3rd AUN ASEAN Experiential Learning Programme (AELP) $18^{th} - 24^{th}$ June 2023

"Smart Nation: Transforming your Nation through Technology" Co-hosted by Nanyang Technological University and National University of Singapore

1. About the Forum

The AUN AELP is a biennial youth activity initiated by AUN-SAN, which aims to serve as a platform for students to undergo experiential learning through knowledge sharing and hands-on activities pertinent to social, economic and environmental issues in ASEAN region.


The AELP activities allow students to enhance ASEAN awareness by increasing their competency, knowledge, and understanding of ASEAN identity and sensitivity to different cultures, languages, and religions as well as increasing cross-cultural communication and leadership skills. The knowledge gained and shared throughout the programme also helps enable collaboration and long-term networking among the participants.

2. Theme: "Smart Nation: Transforming your Nation through Technology"

The AELP 2023 will explore the concept of smart nation, which transcends across a myriad of industries and aspects of a nation through 4 pillars namely;

- 1. Township Planning: Tech-enabled sustainable town
- 2. Transport: Leveraging technology to enhance transport systems
- 3. Healthcare: Response to Covid and the future of healthcare
- 4. Digital-ready Society: Inclusion of citizenry in digital transformation

This year's programme operates on the following 3-step process to provide a fulfilling and rewarding experiential learning journey;



Learn

The participants would be put through talks and sharing sessions where context and baseline knowledge will be imparted. This ensures that everyone is on a level playing field and has the knowledge required to proceed onto the next step of the process.

Experience

After having some broad knowledge on Smart Nation concepts, the participants would undergo interactive experiences that would provide them hands-on opportunities to self-discover and thus gain a deeper understanding of the concepts taught previously.

Apply

Finally, with personal hands-on experience, the participants would have the necessary knowledge to synthesise new ideas themselves. They will be put in diverse groups where they can mix their newly-acquired knowledge and personal experiences to co-create solutions to the provided problem statements. This step is crucial as it reinforces learnt concepts through practice.

3. Programme Objectives

- 1) To engage students in experiential learning and cultural immersion, through a slew of activities, field trips, discussion sessions and a comprehensive end-of-program presentation.
- 2) To provide a platform for knowledge sharing on pertinent issues affecting the ASEAN region in tandem with opportunities for students to apply knowledge gained when they return home for possible national and regional projects.
- 3) To share knowledge, experiences and practices on sociocultural aspects and connect all ASEAN university delegates which could lead to potential collaborative student activities between member universities.

4. Expected Outcomes:

- Participants develop their skill set through experiential learning and hands-on activities
- Participants gain both soft and hard skills from the programme
- Participants create strong networking between students and universities in ASEAN
- Gain life-changing and eye-opening cross border experiences
- Participants are able to apply and utilise knowledges, skills, and experiences gained from AELP programme in real life and for future use
